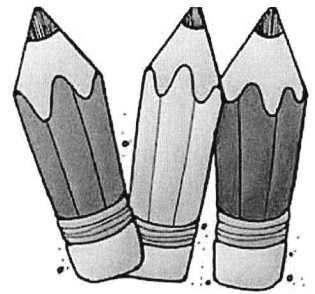

- 2 white polymer erasers (big)
- 2 pairs of scissors
- 12 glue sticks (no jumbo or scented)
- 1 glue bottle
- 1 pack of skinny dry erase markers (black)
- 2 boxes of 24 count Crayola Crayons
- 1 box of wide Crayola Markers
- 1 box of skinny Crayola Markers
- 1 box of Crayola Colored Pencils (12 or 24 count)
- 2 folders
- 1 zipper pencil pouch for Fancy Friday (big enough to hold 2 glue sticks, 2 pencils, and crayons)
- 2 big highlighters (yellow)
- 2 pkg wide-ruled notebook paper
- 2 composition notebooks
- 2 notebooks of choice (creative writing, drawing during read aloud)
- 1 ruler (metric/English)
- 1 set of headphones or earbuds
- 1 wireless mouse (this is optional, but helpful if the child isn't familiar with a mouse pad)
- 2 large box of Kleenex
- 2 packages of unscented baby wipes (used for cleaning hands/ wiping desks after lunch)
- 1 pair of slippers/slides for inside the classroom on rainy/snowy day
- 1 box plastic spoons or forks

- 1 package of paper plates
- 1 box of ziploc sandwich bags
- 1 package of napkins
