Please Bring:

- 1 pkg. of 24 Ticonderoga Pencils
- 2 white polymer erasers
- 2 pairs of Scissors
- 4 wide-lined one subject composition notebooks @ least 80 sheets & threaded together (**no spirals please!**)
- 12 glue sticks
- 3 boxes of 24 count Crayola Crayons
- 1 box of each skinny and wide Crayola Markers
- 1 pkg. of Crayola Colored Pencils (12 or 24 count regular or twistable)
- 3-ring binder (**1 inch hardcover with pockets inside**)
- 1 zippered pencil pouch for binder
- 1 zippered pencil pouch for Fancy Friday (big enough to fit scissors, 2 glue sticks, 2 pencils, and crayons)
- 1 package of 8 plastic dividers **with pockets** for binder
- 1 two pocket folder (preferably plastic/poly)
- 2 highlighters (yellow only)
- 2 thick & 2 extra fine tip Expo markers (Black ink only)
- 1 pencil box/school box (All of your child's markers, colored pencils, scissors, & 2 glue sticks should fit)
- 1 ruler with inches, half inch, quarter inch, and centimeters
- 1 set of headphones or earbuds
- 1 wireless mouse (optional, but helpful if child is not handy with a mouse pad)
- 2 box of Kleenex
- 1 box or package of paper plates or spoons or forks.
- 2 packages of unscented *baby* wipes (used for washing hands & wiping down desks after lunch)
- 1 Sketchbook or coloring book or extra composition book for personal use during free time
- 1 Pair of slippers/slides for inside the classroom on rainy days & boot days during winter
